MANDEVILLE OFSTED



Mandeville had a graded OFSTED inspection on Tuesday and Wednesday of this week. This was the follow up inspection after OFSTED said in September 2022 that 'there is enough evidence of improved performance to

suggest that the school could be judged outstanding' Four inspectors were with the school for two full days and looked into all aspects of school life from nursery to year 6, visiting lessons, playtimes, support for SEND, lunch provision and extended day. They looked at children's learning in great detail including a selection of children's work books and analysed our curriculum in great detail to look for exemplary practice in all areas. They met with parents in the playground, the local authority school improvement partner and our governors. Very importantly they held several meetings with children of all ages to ask them about their school.

They then decided grades for each of those areas. At present the outcome is confidential, as the inspectors judgements now have to go through a quality control process. The full report and outcome will be published in around 4-6 weeks.

A huge thank you to the amazing effort by Mandeville staff children, parents, the Gayhurst & Kingsmead staff, our community and all our school governors.

We are pleased about how it went and look forward to sharing the outcome with you as soon as we are allowed to.

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FAMILY COACH PARENT GROUP AT MANDEVILLE

The Family coach service are running a Parent Empowerment group consisting of 5 sessions at Mandeville Primary School with a focus on Increasing Confidence and Reducing Stress. These sessions are free and are for families with children who have special educational needs (in any of the 4 areas of SEN: sensory & physical, cognition & learning, communication & interaction or social, emotional and mental health). No formal diagnosis or EHCP required. The sessions will be on Tuesdays from 9—10am but Rachel said the group are happy to wait for Kingsmead parents to walk over from Kingsmead after dropping their children at 8.50am so if you can't get there till a few minutes after 9am that's fine! The first session starts on Tuesday 27th February. Spaces are limited—only 10 available, for Kingsmead and Mandeville families. - To finish creating your account, you just need to set a password. You can do this by going to login.arbor.sc. clicking on 'Forgotten Password?' and following the instructions on screen.
- You will have already received an email with your username.
