LEAP FEDERATION HAT TRICK!



Mandeville received their official OFSTED report this week and we're delighted to be able to share with you that they were graded Outstanding in all areas. We are very proud that in the last year all three LEAP schools **Gayhurst**, **Kingsmead** and now **Mandeville** have been graded as Outstanding by OFSTED. We

hope that speaks to the strength of the federation in working together as a group of Local Authority maintained schools. As a federation we have built our team to work together and achieved economies of scale both financially and in terms of workload for our staff. Headteachers work very closely together under the overall leadership of our Executive Headteacher and in this way all challenges and opportunities can be shared and the pressures on individuals reduced. For children this means a wider understanding of the borough they live in and a chance to regularly partner with children at other schools. It also means access to specialist teachers & wellbeing provision that could not be afforded by one school alone but can be shared across the federation.

HACKNEY RE CALENDAR COMPETITION

The annual Hackney RE calendar competition has commenced for 2024-25. Last year, LEAP schools made up almost half of the calendar illustrations (5 winners). It would be great to have more winners from LEAP this year. All the artwork is selected through a boroughwide poster competition, which is open to all pupils across from Year 1 upwards in Hackney Schools. Entries: ALL entries (originals only) should be:


- On A4 landscape, preferably on coloured paper and/ or using strong/bold colours – i.e. felt pens or paints, rather than pale pencils

EXTENDED DAY CHANGES

A reminder of the changes to Kingsmead's before and after school offer to families that are happening this term:

BREAKFAST CLUB

<u>Usual free breakfast club</u>

Our **FREE** breakfast club offer continues to run Monday to Friday from **8.10 - 8.50am** & is open to Rec to Yr 6 children.

New paid for early start session

An additional offer for those that need an earlier start due to work commitments is now available from **7.45** - **8.10am** for a **charge of £1 per child** per day. This needs to be booked the day before (by calling the school office) and paid for in advance via Parent Pay. Please note children will not be admitted to the early start session unless their place has been booked & paid for. DO NOT send your child to school before 8.10am if they are attending the Free breakfast club only.

AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITY HOUR

After school clubs now have a charge of $\pounds 1$ per session per child ($\pounds 10$ per term per club as each club will run for 10 weeks each term). Families eligible for Pupil Premium will qualify for ONE free After School club each term. Letters and club application forms have been sent out to all families with children in Rec to Year 6, explaining this new system with a timetable of clubs that will be on offer for this Summer Term.

Families should now have had their After School clubs places confirmed by the school office. After school clubs will start next week on **Monday 22nd April**. Please note payment needs to be made by Monday 22 April via Parentpay.

COFFEE MORNING: MEET THE SPEECH & LANGUAGE THERAPIST
