<p>WWW...</p> <p>What went well ...</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clear Learning Intention helping children understand what they meant to be learning• Children using learning voices with their talk partners x2• Steps to Success being used so children know how to progress with their work.• Teacher explaining things clearly and in a straightforward way x 3• Children actively engaged with their learning and producing good work/learning new methods & strategies x 3• Children well behaved and focused x 3 (making it easier for teacher to teach)• Positive learning atmosphere in classroom• Children taking time and care over their work not rushing it• Teacher making good use of whiteboard and other resources• Teacher making good use of strategies to get the children's attention (xylophone, count down...)• Teacher engaging whole class and making sure they all know what they should be doing• Good use of mental and aural starters• Calm, encouraging manner of teacher
<p>EBI...</p> <p>Lessons would be even better if ...</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• More time at the end of the lesson for children to share their work with each other• The teacher used lollypop sticks even more to make sure different children answered questions• Children were a little quieter at times of transition• More challenges given to some children• More time in the lesson for children to ask questions and/or do more talk partner work• The children had been faster writing date and title in their books• The teacher had clearer instructions when the children needed to stop what they were doing
